

# Fight Blight



Itasca County is sponsoring a project to help diminish blight in Itasca County. The name of this project is “*Fight Blight*”. The county has asked all townships to get the word out and volunteer to help *Fight Blight* within their townships.

Itasca County will do the following:

- Provide FREE dumpsters at the Wabana Townhall for township property owners to put in garbage and landfill materials. There is no charge to the Township for the use of these dumpsters.
- Provide information materials listing permitted and not permitted items to go in the dumpsters (**see list**).
- Designate areas where items will be piled up **outside** of the dumpsters like tires, appliances, old furniture and demolition materials.
- Will be there on the first day for training/explaining and get us started.
- Haul the dumpsters away at the end of the event.

What Wabana Township needs to do:

- **Provide volunteers to monitor the dumpsters.** Not everything is allowed in the dumpsters (**see list**).
- Provide the communication to the township residents to get the word out.
