Attend the Town Board Annual Meeting Tuesday, March 14 at 7 p.m.

Residents may participate in their township government at the Wabana Township Annual Meeting on Tuesday, March 14 at 7 p.m. The annual meeting will be held in person and by **Zoom**. At the annual meeting, permanent residents can vote on the recommended levy. At the January budget meeting, the board discussed the 2023 budget and will consider the following recommended levy at the March 14 annual meeting:

General Fund 75,945 45,650 Road & Bridge. Fire 29,000 Total \$150,595

The 2022 levy was \$150,735.


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Ruth Fordham recognized for serving as Township Clerk
