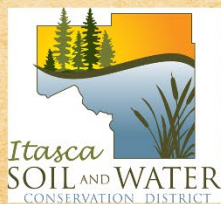

Position Title:	Aquatic Invasive Species Level 2 Watercraft Inspector
Position Status:	Seasonal
Employment Duration:	May 6, 2024, through October 12, 2024 (Flexible)
Starting Pay:	\$17.00 per hour
Hours:	Flexible 4 to 10-hour daylight shifts, not to exceed 40 hrs./wk. Must be able to work weekends and holidays.

Position Summary: A L2 serves to inform and educate the public about the threats of aquatic invasive species (AIS) to Minnesota's waters. L2 inspectors work at public water access sites and show individuals how to inspect and remove aquatic invasive species from their boating equipment. Level 2 inspectors transport and operate a hot-water pressure washer and perform decontamination services using hot, high-pressure water.

Full time and part time positions are available. Shift length may vary from 4 – 10 daylight hours. Weekend and holiday work are required. Workload can vary dramatically from busy to light, based on weather, boater activity, local fishing conditions, school, holiday schedules and other factors. Starting pay is \$17.00 per hour.

All Level 2 Watercraft Inspectors must attend and pass both the DNR Level One & Level Two AIS Watercraft Inspector training class and a criminal background check.

Minimum Qualifications:

- At least 18 years of age
- Available to work weekends, weekdays, and holidays on a regular basis. Our season runs from May 6 to October 12. Full and part-time daylight hours. Start and end dates are flexible.
- A Valid Minnesota Class D Driver's License and insurance.
- Good customer service skills and ability to work with the public and in a field setting.
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Able to communicate effectively.
- Must be able to operate a pressure washer and basic hand tools.
- Must be able to lift fifty pounds.
- Must be able to stand for prolonged periods, reach, kneel and climb in and out of boats.
- Must complete an online training session on watercraft inspection and decontamination and additional training as specified.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Computer and smartphone literate
- Experience using trucks, trailers, and hand tools.
